

Hi, this is Traci with enJoy Movies Your Way and I'm going to show you how to uninstall the enJoy software program.

First, you will notice that I have the enJoy shortcut on my desktop. When I uninstall the program, this shortcut won't be there anymore.




For this tutorial, I'm using Windows Vista. I will click the Start button, then All Programs, then scroll down to find enJoy. Then click on enJoy, then Uninstall enJoy.



When I see the message, "Are you sure you want to uninstall this product?", I will click Yes.

For Vista, I will see a User Account Control message asking me if I trust this program. I will click Allow.



And that's it. We have now uninstalled the enJoy software program.

NOTE: When upgrading to a new version of enJoy, first uninstall the old version, then install the new version. When you uninstall enJoy, it actually leaves your database file there. DO NOT

delete your database file unless you want your filters gone forever! When you install the new version of enJoy, it will use your old database file (with all of your filters in it).
