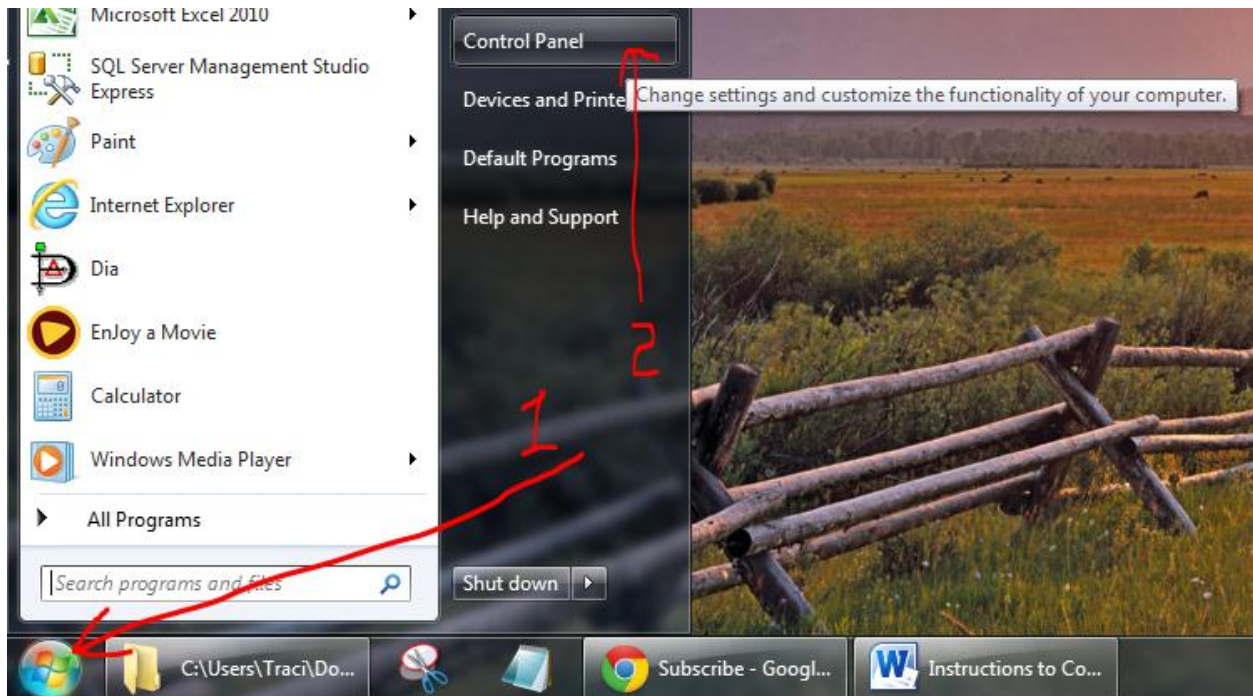
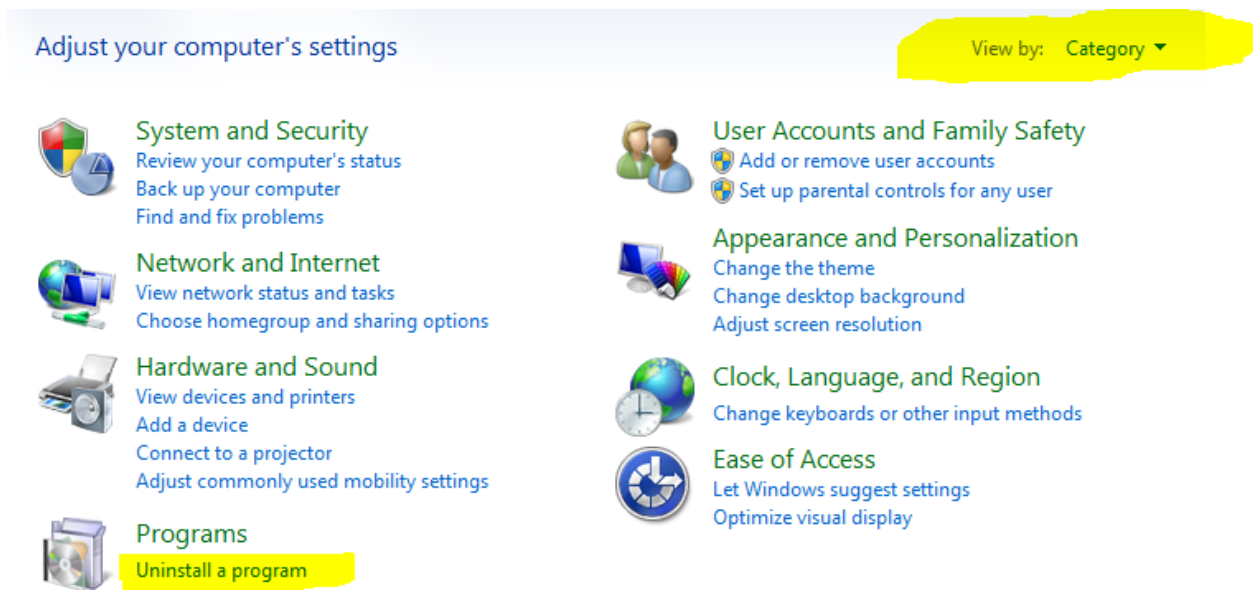

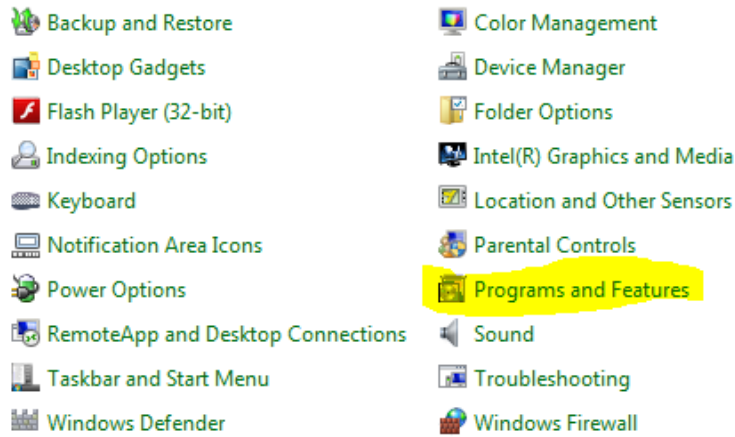


1. Start.

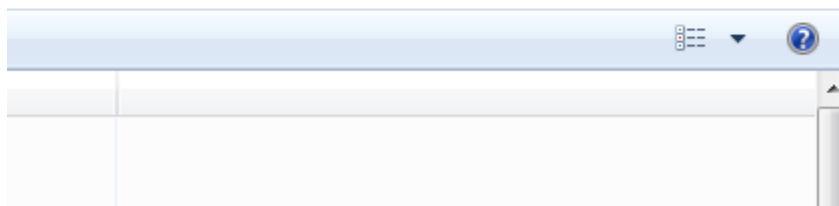
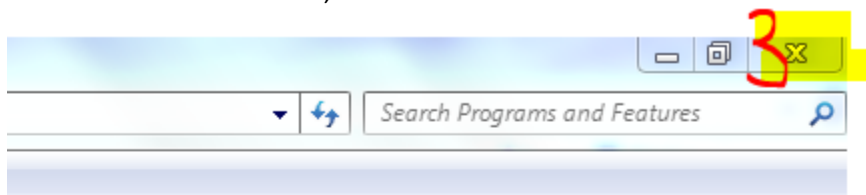
### Uninstall or change a program

To uninstall a program, select it from the list and then click Uninstall, Change, or Repair.

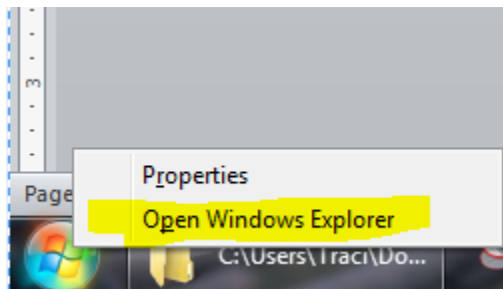

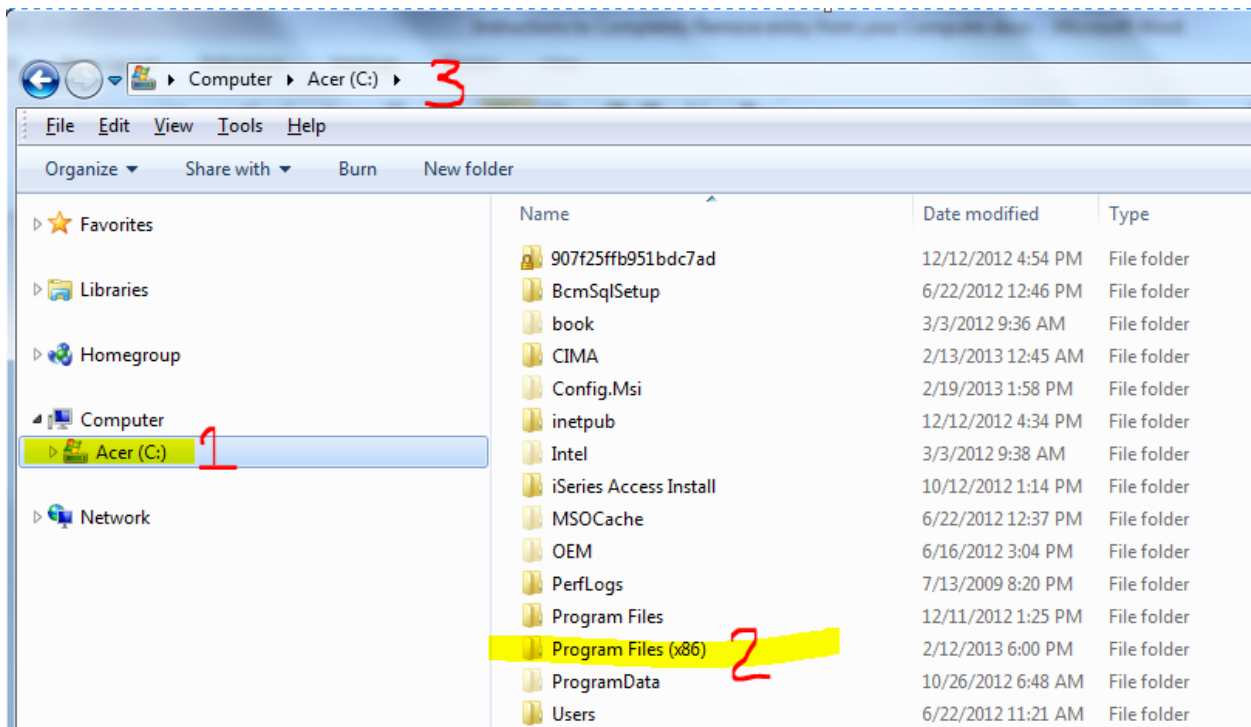
1. Select Enjoy Player.
2. Click Uninstall.
3. When it is finished, close Control Panel.



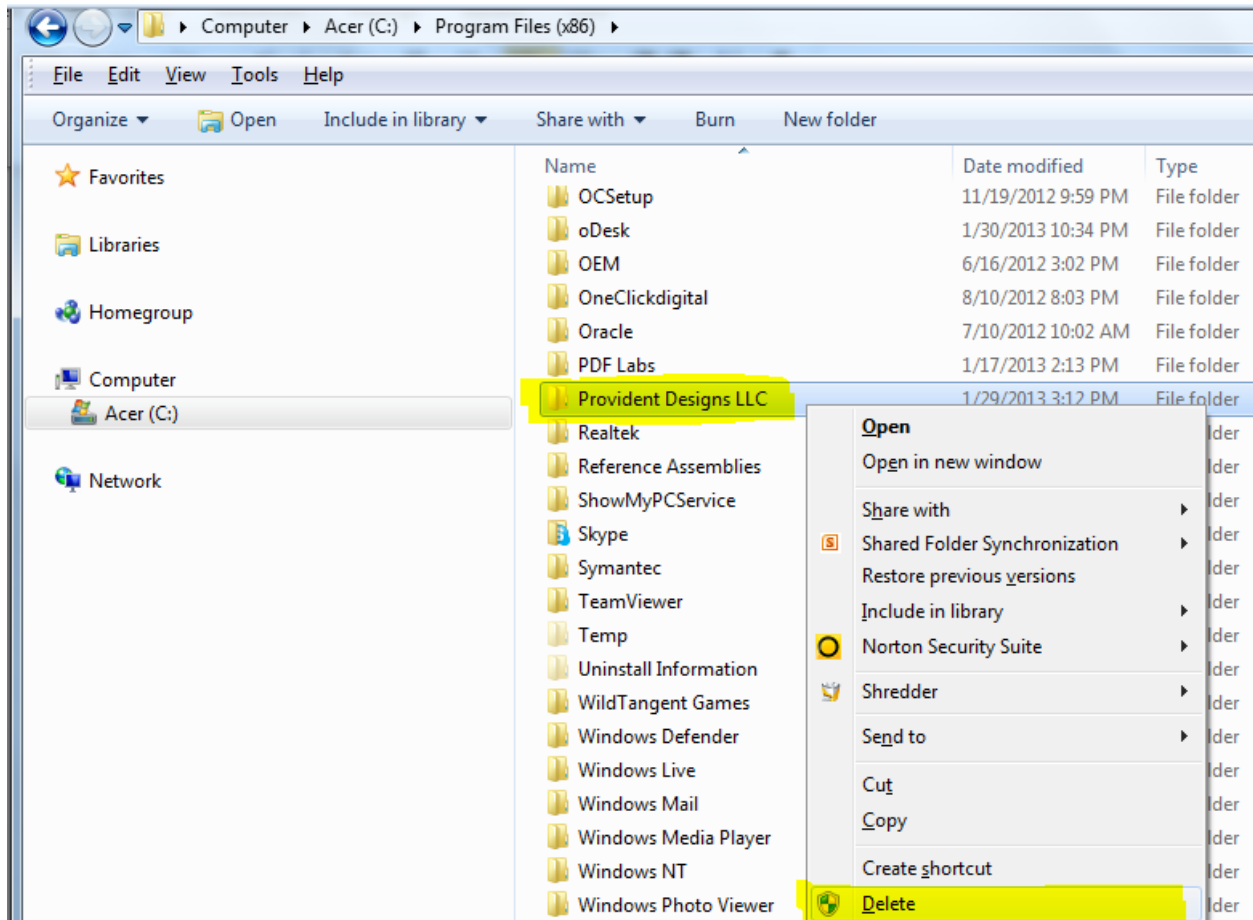
Even though enjoy has been uninstalled, it left some back-up files in the program folder. You should remove this folder from your computer.



1. Right-click on the Start button and you will see a popup menu.
2. Choose "Explore" or "Open Windows Explorer" – click on it with your left mouse button.



1. Double-click on your hard-drive (C:).
2. Double-click on Program Files (x86).
3. As you keep double-clicking, you will see the path above.



Find the folder called Provident Designs LLC. Right-click on it and you will see a popup menu. Left click on Delete. This will permanently remove enjoy from your computer.

Note: If you are deleting enjoy version 1.5 or later, then you will want to delete these two folders:

- C:\Program Files (x86)\enJoy ← These are left-over program files
- C:\Users\**Your User Name**\AppData\Roaming\enJoy ← This is where the filters are stored.
